ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBER RECRUITMENT - SKAMANIA COUNTY

The Area Agency on Aging & Disabilities of Southwest Washington (AAADSW), a multi-service public agency helping older adults and adults with disabilities remain in their homes, has openings on its Advisory Council for Skamania County representatives. Advisory Council members serve one three-year term and may apply for a second three-year term.

Advisory Council members play an important role in the agency. They:

- Apprise AAADSW leadership about the needs of older adults, adults with disabilities and family caregivers in their respective communities.
- Inform community members about program and service offerings through AAADSW.
- Provide input on new and existing program and service offerings, as well as funding to local service providers.
- Assist in the development of the Agency's four-year Area Plan.

The Advisory Council meets every third Wednesday of the month in various locations throughout the five-county service area. Travel expenses will be reimbursed.
